PURPOSE The Otero County Law Enforcement Appreciation was established in 2014. The scholarship was established in 2018 for children of law enforcement officers in Otero County and those students who actively involve themselves in organizations & clubs that promote and support law enforcement. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals that are enrolled in criminal justice study in community colleges, colleges and universities. The **OCLEAC** Scholarship principally targets first and second year academic students.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in criminal justice programs including but not limited to volunteer hours. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The **OCLEAC** awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. The OCLEAC pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient. Scholarships are awarded annually. The **OCLEAC** Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college, university or vocational school in New Mexico for the upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant.
- Applicants must be a resident of Otero County New Mexico and the United States.
- Scholarship winners may be asked to supply a photograph of themselves.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by **April 6, 2018**.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due **April 6 of the current calendar year**.
- Candidates may be asked for a interview by the Scholarship Committee conducted in March.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by May 1, 2018.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official proof of academic standing.
- A letter of academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- A letter completed reference from an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic school for post-secondary studies.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Awards will be given by May 1, 2018.
- Applicant must provide their **student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be used**.
- Award amounts will be distributed annually after all requirements are met.

OTERO COUNTY LAW ENFORCMENT APPRECIATION COMMITTEE: SCHOLARSHIPS

OCLEAC Scholarship – The **OCLEAC** offers two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$500 each to an Otero County college student (one freshman and one sophomore standing) pursuing a career course of study in any field. This scholarship will also be offered to students attending a vocational school in their first or second year.

Criminal Justice Scholarship Freshman – The **OCLEAC** offers a scholarship in the amount of \$500 to an Otero County college student entering college at a freshman level pursuing a degree or certificate in the field of Criminal Justice.

Criminal Justice Scholarship Sophomore – The **OCLEAC** offers a scholarship in the amount of \$500 to an Otero County college student (at least sophomore standing) pursuing a degree or certificate in the field of Criminal Justice.

NOTE: Recipients of each of these scholarships MAY be approved for subsequent awards via application renewal, proof of eligibility (minimum GPA and enrollment in NMSU), and compliance with stated curriculum/degree plan.
