**PURPOSE** The Otero County Law Enforcement Appreciation was established in 2014. The scholarship was established in 2018 for children of certified law enforcement officers in Otero County and those students who actively involve themselves in organizations & clubs that promote and support law enforcement. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals that are enrolled in criminal justice study in community colleges, colleges and universities. The **OCLEAC** Scholarship principally targets first and second year academic students.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in criminal justice programs including but not limited to volunteer hours. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

#### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The **OCLEAC** awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. The OCLEAC pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient. Scholarships are awarded annually. The **OCLEAC** Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

## **CRITERIA**

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college, university or vocational school in New Mexico for the upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant.
- Applicants must be a resident of Otero County New Mexico and the United States.
- Parent(s) of applicant must be a certified law enforcement officer in Otero County, NM.
- Scholarship winners may be asked to supply a photograph of themselves.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by April 1, 2020.

## **TIMELINE**

- Applications are due April 1 of the current calendar year.
- Candidates may be asked for a interview by the Scholarship Committee conducted in April.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by April 22, 2020.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is April 1, 2020.
- 2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
- 4. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you.
- 5. You will be notified by phone or e-mail by April 22, 2020 regarding the status of your application.

- Completed application form.
- Official proof of academic standing.
- A letter of academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- A letter completed reference from an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic school for post-secondary studies.
- Parental employment verification from law enforcement agency in Otero County NM.
   If recently employed employment verification letter on employer's letterhead indicating start date.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

- Scholarships will be awarded on May 2, 2020 at the annual Otero County Law Enforcement Appreciation Banquet
- Award amounts will be distributed after all requirements are met.
- OCLEAC Scholarship The OCLEAC offers scholarships in the amount of \$500 each to an Otero County
  college student pursuing a career course of study in any field. This scholarship will also be offered to
  students attending a vocational school.
- NOTE: Recipients of each of these scholarships MAY be approved for subsequent awards via application renewal, proof of eligibility (minimum GPA and enrollment in a college, university or vocational school) and compliance with stated curriculum/degree plan.
